“One day Multi-Stakeholders Regional Orientation Workshop of North Eastern States including Sikkim to focus on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) participation for strengthening the Child Welfare & Child Wellbeing mechanism in NE States ”

Applications are invited from NGOs/CSOs from 8 North Eastern States for the above mentioned regional CSR convention of 8 NE States.

1. Objective of the Convention:

- Provide a platform facilitating understanding between the Leading Corporate Houses/PSUs and Social Sector viz. CSO/NGOs of North Eastern States having children as their focus area.
- Gain a clear understanding about the situation of children in the North Eastern States , with a particular focus on Child Welfare and Child Wellbeing ;
- Convene all key Corporates who has a mandate to invest on CSR related projects and discuss about how various components of Child Welfare and Well being related systems and services could be strengthened in North Eastern States through their active participation;
- Come up with a “Road map for Companies to Invest for Child Welfare and Wellbeing initiatives in the North Eastern States”.

2. Proposed Participants:

- Representatives of Corporate Houses/PSUs operating in the 8 North Eastern States including Sikkim.
- North East DONER Ministry.
- Concerned Government Departments viz. Social Welfare, Education, Home, Labour & Employment, Skill Development, Industry and Commerce etc.
- NGOs/ CSOs working in the field of ‘Child Welfare, Child Well-being and Child Education initiatives.
- Child Right Commissions of the respective States.

3. Venue:

Venue Taj Vivanta, Guwahati

4. Date:

This workshop shall be held on 5th June 2017 in Guwahati, Assam. The program schedule and invite letters for the selected organisation/s shall be communicated separately.

5. Selection Criteria for NGOs/ CSOs:

The NGOs/CSOs shall be selected by the organiser based on the selection criteria as prescribed in the format placed at Annexure A. The organiser shall have sole discretion to select or not to select any organisation based on its criteria. Organisation who shall receive invites from the organiser may attend. The filled up application form duly attested by the NGO/CSO should reach the Commission (Soft and Hard Copy) not later than 10 days from the date of posting the advertisement on the website of the Commission.

6. Expected Outcome

Providing an understanding between the Corporate Houses/PSUs with the Social Sector organisations viz. suitable CSOs/NGOs of North Eastern States having children as their focus area.

7. Local Transport/TA

Organiser shall not bear TA/DA for local transport of the participant NGOs/CSOs. The NGO partners are requested to make their own arrangements for stay in Guwahati. The Commission shall bear all the expenses related breakfast, lunch and evening tea/coffee etc. during the convention day only i.e. 05th June 2017 at Taj Vivanta, Guwahati, Assam.
