In pursuance of approval of the Govt. of Assam vide Letter No. VFV.251/2014/76 dated Dispur the 17th May, 2017 and VFV.251/2014/110 dated 10th August, 2018 applications are invited from the intending male & female candidates from Bodoland Territorial Council and North Cachar Hills Autonomous Council of Assam for undergoing **V.F.A. Training Course** for one year Elementary Knowledge on A.H. & Veterinary Science for the Session 2017-18 at the School of Veterinary Science & A.H. Assam at Ghungoor, Silchar for admission against 55 and 24 nos of seats respectively (Total 79 nos) and will be received up to 5.00 pm of ~~23rd~~ ^{15th} September, 2018 for admission against 79 number of seats as mentioned here under:

Reservation: Existing Reservation Policy of the Govt. of Assam shall be followed:

The candidates who have earlier applied in response to the advertisement dated 29.07.2017 but could not be invited for interview due to High Court's order dated 28/08/2017 in WP(C) No.5124/2018 need not apply again.

Age: A candidate should not be less than 17 years and more than **30 years** of age as on **01.01.2017**. The upper age limit is relaxable for the candidates of reserved categories as per existing provision.

Entry Qualification:

Minimum educational qualification required for admission is **H S (Sc.) passed with Biology** as a subject from the recognized University/ Board as per Govt. Notification No.VFV.155/2013/62 dated 06/07/2017.

How to Apply : -

1. The prescribed Application Forms will have to be **downloaded** from the Govt. of Assam's website assam.gov.in and submitted along with a fee of **Rs.100/** for General & OBC **Rs 50/** for ST & SC candidates by way of **Crossed Indian Postal Order** duly pledged in favour of the **Principal, School of Veterinary Science & A.H. Assam at Ghungoor, Silchar** payable at the Post Office, Silchar Medical College, Silchar.

Intended candidates may also contact the Office of the Director, A.H. & Veterinary Department, BTC, Kokrajhar, BTAD, Assam and Additional Director, A.H. & Veterinary Department (Hills), Assam Haflong, Dima Hasao as the case may be for the **hard Copy of Application Form**.

No Bank Draft/Money Order/ Cash or Cheque will be accepted for issuance of Application forms.

2. **Last date of submission of Application Form:**

The 15th September, 2018 up to 5.00 pm.

No application shall be entertained after expiry of specified date.

3. Duly filled in Application Forms along with required testimonials shall have to be submitted along with a self addressed stamped (Rs.5.00 only) envelope of 23x11cm size, at any one of the following offices either by **Registered Post** or **by hand** in the Drop Box during Office hours:

Other Terms & Conditions

1. Candidates must be residents of respective areas of Bodoland Territorial Area Districts (BTAD) and Dima Hasao District under NCHAC as the case may be and should enclose copy of the Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC) along with the Application.
2. Since the practice of furnishing attested copies of certificates/mark sheets etc. by competent authority has been discontinued by the Govt., the applicant shall furnish copies of certificate/mark sheet etc. declared by himself/herself as certified to be true copy of the original along with the application.
3. Incomplete and defective applications will be summarily rejected.
4. The candidates whose applications are found complete in all respects will be called for an interview before the Selection Committee. The candidates will have to produce all original certificates and testimonials before the Selection Committee at the time of interview.
5. The date of interview will be notified in due course of time.
6. a. The eligible candidates belonging to BTAD Areas will have to appear for interview at the Office of the Director, A.H. & Veterinary Deptt., BTC, Kokrajhar.
b. The eligible candidates belonging to Hill District of Dima Hasao will have to appear for interview at the Office of the Additional Director, A.H. & Vety. Deptt. (Hills), Dima Hasao, Haflong, Assam.
7. In service candidates will have to apply through proper channel.
8. No TA/DA will be admissible for appearing the interview.
9. Canvassing either directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidate
10. The list of eligible candidates will be displayed in the Office Notice Board of the Directorate of A.H. & Vety. Deptt., Guwahati-3; Principal, School of Veterinary Science & A.H. at Ghungoor, Silchar, Assam; Director, BTC, Kokrajhar, Assam and the Addl. Director (Hills), A.H. & Vety. Deptt., Assam, Haflong. The List of eligible candidates will also be made available in assam.gov.in and *Department's website*.
11. Individual Call Letters will also be sent to the eligible candidates in their respective postal address. However, the department will not be responsible for postal delay in receipt of Call Letters in time. Obcourse, non receipt of Call Letters in time will not make them ineligible to appear in interview provided that the eligible candidates produce Identity Card along with Original testimonials at the time of Interview.
12. The selection of candidates would be made on the basis of existing Selection Procedure as under:
 - a. 50% of the percentage of Marks obtained in H.S. Science with Biology and –
 - b. 50% of the percentage of Marks obtained in the Viva-Voce Examination.

The total marks obtained as mentioned hereinabove would be taken into consideration for selection of candidates on Merit basis with due consideration to Reservation policy.
13. The Roll Numbers of the selected candidates will be notified through leading Regional/Local daily English Assamese, Bengali, Bodo and Dimasa Newspapers Published from Guwahati, Kokrajhar and Haflong, Assam. The List of selected candidates will also be made available in assam.gov.in and *Department's website animalhusbandry.assam.gov.in*.
14. The selected candidates will have to undergo the training course at their own expense.
15. The selected candidates from BTC & N.C Hills Autonomous Council shall have to execute a bond prior to admission to the course stating therein that they will serve in the respective areas of BTAD/NCHAC.
16. Subject to availability of vacancy and observance of Rules & Regulations, the successful trainees will be appointed time to time by the respective council. However, the authority shall not be bound to provide appointment/jobs on completion of the course.
17. The candidates selected for admission will have to produce physical fitness certificate from the District/Sub-Divisional Medical and Health Officers.
