- 4. The Selection Committee constituted as per the provision of the Electricity Act, 2003 for the purpose of making the selection to the post of Member (Law), reserves the right to consider and recommend any other person fulfilling the criteria laid down in the Act for the post of the Member (Law) apart from those who have applied against this advertisement. The Head Quarter of Assam Electricity Regulatory Commission is in Guwahati.

- 1. As per the clause 217(2) of the Constitution of India "A person shall not be qualified for appointment as Judge of a High Court unless he is a citizen of India and
 - a) has for at least ten years held a judicial office in the territory of India; or
- b) has for at least ten years been an advocate of a High Court or of two or more such Courts in succession.
- 2.
